
Ethanol production shift of Feedstocks & Incentivization



Ethanol Production split based on feedstock-crore litres




- National Policy on Biofuels 2018, expanded permissible feedstocks for ethanol production to include grains and damaged food grains.
- In ESY 2024, grain-based ethanol production surpassed sugarcane-based output

Government Incentive structure for ethanol production

 The incentive pattern of the government for ethanol production from different feedstocks has significantly altered feedstock utilization patterns, with maize's contribution to ethanol production rising to 36% in 2023-24 from almost negligible in 2021-22.
